PSAT/NMSQT Testing

All current 10th and 11th graders are scheduled to take the Preliminary SAT/National Merit Scholarship Qualifying Test (PSAT/NMSQT) test on Tuesday, January 26th, 2021. **The exam will take place in person on Da Vinci's campus.** This exam measures what you're learning in school to determine if you're on track, as well as connect you with opportunities for financial scholarships. By taking the exam, you will be connected to over \$300 million in scholarships, are eligible for the National Merit Scholarship Program, will learn more about your academic strengths and have access to free, personalized test prep. 


