Our family math night was also a great success. Our hope is that you continue to reinforce the ideas and activities learned at home.

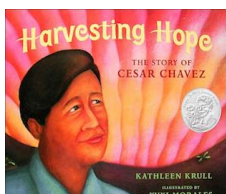
