Pre-K3 and Pre-K4

Vista del Futuro is proud to announce that we have been approved by TEA to have our Pre-K3 & Pre-K4 classes fully funded. To find out if your child is eligible for free public Pre-K3 or Pre-K4 visit tea.texas.gov and type in "General Prekindergarten FAQ." If you do not qualify for the free public classes, there is a small fee to have your child enrolled. Keep in mind your child must be 3 by September 01, 2020. If you have any questions, please call 915-855-8143.

Our Pre-K3 & Pre-K4 students are full time, starting their day at 7:45am and ending it at 1:45pm. All students attend physical education class, music class, Spanish class, and follow a rigorous early childhood education curriculum.

Vista del Futuro also has an onsite afterschool daycare that students my utilize for ten dollars a day.


