The truth is, the VA offers a variety of health care services from basic primary care all the way to nursing home care. You must do your research to assure the right care for you and your situation.

#### Some Reasons to Enroll

- ▼ VA health care meets the minimum essential coverage requirements under the Affordable Care Act.
- No open season or waiting period for health care coverage.
- ▼ Veterans can apply for VA health care enrollment at any time.
- ▶ No enrollment fee, monthly premiums or deductibles.
- Many Veterans have no out-of-pocket costs. (Some Veterans may have to pay small copayments for health care or prescription drugs.)
- ▼ VA offers a comprehensive medical benefits package that is generally available to all enrolled Veterans.
