### \* Summer Tutoring for HB 1416

In Texas, mandatory school tutoring is governed by **House Bill 1416**, which requires districts to provide 15 to 30 hours of supplemental accelerated instruction to students who do not score "Approaches Grade Level" or higher on STAAR exams in grades 3-8 or End-of-Course (EOC) assessments.

## DaVinci San Antonio Academy Welding Pathway: Building Skills for the Future

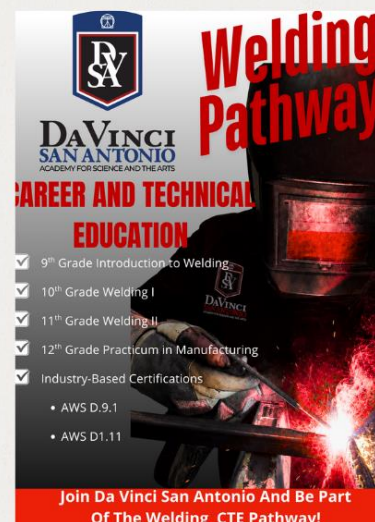
At DaVinci San Antonio Academy (DVSA), students have the opportunity to gain valuable hands-on experience and industry-recognized credentials through our Career and Technical Education (CTE) Welding Pathway. This four-year program is designed to prepare students for high-demand careers in manufacturing, construction, engineering, and skilled trades. Students begin their journey in 9th Grade with Introduction to Welding, where they learn foundational safety practices, tools, and welding techniques. As they progress through Welding I and Welding II, students develop advanced technical skills, gain real-world experience, and explore career opportunities within the welding industry.

During their senior year, students participate in a Practicum in Manufacturing, allowing them to apply their knowledge in authentic workplace settings while preparing for postsecondary education or direct entry into the workforce.

A key component of the DVSA Welding Pathway is the opportunity to earn industry-based certifications, including:

- AWS D9.1
- AWS D1.1

These credentials demonstrate students' technical proficiency and provide a competitive advantage in today's job market.



DVSA is committed to providing students with meaningful career pathways that combine academic excellence with workforce readiness. Through our Welding CTE Program, students graduate with the skills, certifications, and confidence needed to pursue successful careers in the skilled trades.

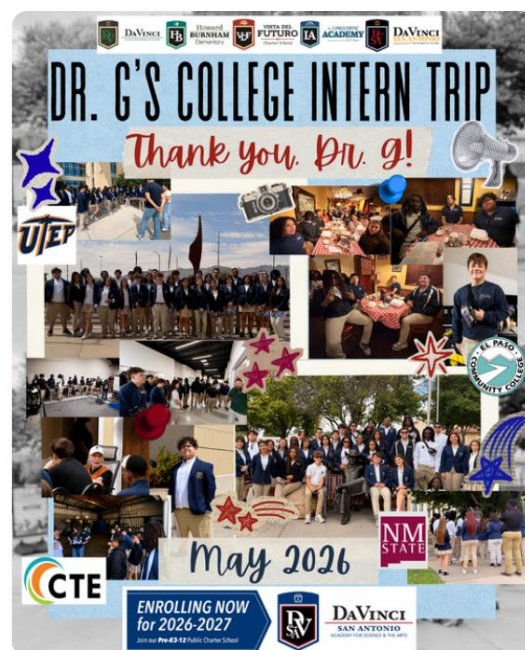
## Dr. G's College Intern Trip to El Paso Inspires Future Leaders

## 2026 STAAR Results

Parents can access Spring 2026 STAAR scores online through the [Texas Assessment Family Portal](#). Scores roll out depending on the test type:

- High School EOC: Available beginning June 10, 2026.
- Grades 3–8: Available beginning June 16, 2026



1. Navigate to the [Texas Assessment Family Portal](#).
2. If you have your child's Unique Student Access Code (found on past report cards) and Date of Birth, you can log in directly.
3. If you don't have the code, click "Lookup Access Code" on the login page. You will need to enter your child's Legal Name, Date of Birth, and either their TSDS/PEIMS ID (Social Security Number) to retrieve the code
